

# Induction hob instructions





#### Legend

- 1 Main switch
- 2 Mode selection and mode change
  - Power levels
  - Temperature levels
- 3 & 5 Parameter changes (increase / decrease)
- 4 Slider touch levels 1-10
- 6 Running time setting
- 7 Key lock

## **Operation / Functions**

#### Induction hob

#### Switch on

- Place cookware on hob & tap ON/OFF button (1)
- Display 00 & signal tone
- Duration 60 seconds, then standby function

#### Select power/temperature levels

- Selecting power levels: Tap the "Function" button (2) once
- Selecting temperature levels: Tap the "Function" button (2) twice
- Change during operation: Tap the "Function" button (2) once

#### Switching off

- Tap the ON/OFF button (1) -> appliance switches to "Standby" - Switch off permanently: Pull out the plug

### Operating time limit

- Automatic switch-off of the hob & standby
- after 2 hours
- if no setting changes are made within this period
- Timer setting > 2 hours overrides automatic switch-off

- Power level
- Temperature level
- Remaining cooking time set
- Residual heat present in the cooking zone (display H, if temp. > 80° C)
- 9 LEDs for displaying the functions
  - Operation with runtime setting
  - Key lock
  - Operation in power mode
  - Operation in temperature levels mode

#### Slider touch operation (4)

Only for selecting / changing power and temperature levels

- Place your finger on the slider touch area - Settings by moving back and forth

## Alternatively

Direct setting by touching a marking

#### Please note

- The following levels can be set with Slider Touch:
- Power levels 1, 2, 4, 6, 8, 10
- Temperature levels 60, 80, 100, 140, 180, 220° C
- Intermediate levels can only be set by direct selection or via "+ / -"

#### Timer

- Press the timer button (6)
- With "+ / -" set duration
- Reset: Press and hold the timer button (6) for 3 seconds

#### **Display lock**

- Activate / deactivate: Press and hold the Lock button (7) for 3 seconds

#### Legend

- A Glass ceramic tile
- B Cooking zones
- C Control panels Cooking zones

#### **Touch Control Sensors**

- Operation is by touch control / tapping the sensor buttons.
- Lock, Timer, Function & OFF/ON
- => Device responds with a signal tone - All other buttons are "mute".

- Notes (avoidance of malfunctions)
- Always keep the control panel clean & dry
- Do not operate with wet fingers
- Do not use as a storage surface
